WATER WHEELS

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on July 8, 2014. Resolution No. 2014-03 for the D.O.T. Road Maintenance Agreement was motioned and passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on August 12, 2014. An amendment of Ordinance No. 101, pertaining to allowable footage of alcohol sales within a church or school, was motioned and passed. The Greenwood Supermarket was in violation of the original ordinance adopted in 1967, this amendment will put them in compliance and allow them to continue to sell alcohol 6 days a week.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on September 9, 2014. Tentative adoption of the millage rate remaining at 1 mill was motioned and passed. The budget for FY2014/2015 was presented to Council. Tentative adoption of the budget for FY2014/2015 was motioned and passed. A discussion was held regarding the FRDAP Grant cycle. Council motioned and approved Andy Easton & Associates to apply

for a \$50,000 grant for improvements to the park and additional recreational activities. Also, the CDBG application will be resubmitted for the 2014/2015 grant cycle. First reading to amend Ordinance No. 101 was read, motioned and passed.

A special meeting was held September 23, 2014. This meeting was for the final adoption of the millage rate at 1 mill and the FY2014/2015 budgets. Both were motioned and passed.
