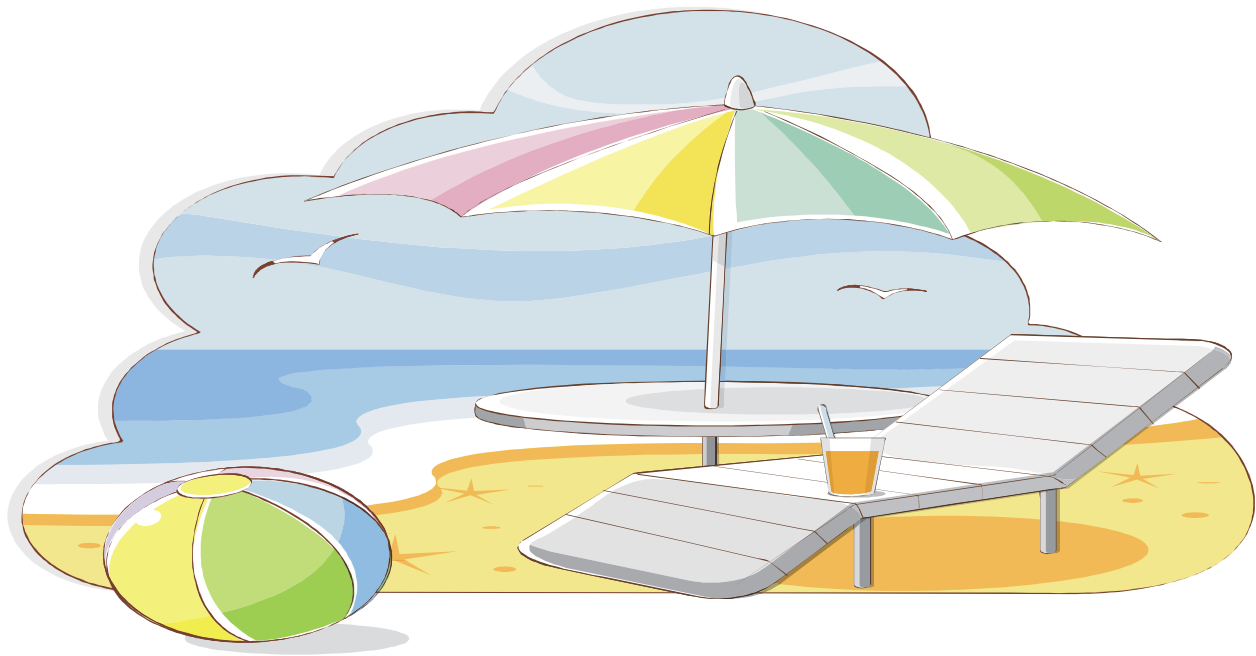

### WATER WHEELS

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on April 8, 2014. Mr. Chris Johnson with Carr, Riggs & Ingram presented the 2012/2013 audit report. Mr. Johnson advised the Town has good, clean books and appreciates our efforts in managing the Town efficiently. Resolution 2014-02 expressing support for the continuation of the ½ Cent Sales Tax was motioned and approved.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on May 13, 2014. Council reviewed and ranked Engineering & Administrative proposals for the CDBG Neighborhood Revitalization Grant Program for FY 2013/2014. Alday-Howell Engineering was chosen for engineering services and Andy Easton & Associates for administrative services. The D.O.T. Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement for 2015/2016 was motioned and approved.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on June 10, 2014. The Council motioned and approved the D.O.T. Highway Lighting,

Maintenance and Compensation Agreement for FY 2014/2015. The D.O.T. Road Maintenance

Contract was approved for a term of two (2) years with a significant cut in funding. The Council did not renew our Terminix contract for the Gym.

### REMINDER

Water and garbage bills are mailed at the end of each month and are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month. A 10% penalty will be applied on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month. **If the total bill, including late charges, is not paid by the 19<sup>th</sup> of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 20<sup>th</sup> of the current month.** If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account.
