WATER WHEELS

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on April 12, 2016. David Fox of Fred Fox Enterprises conducted the Second Public Hearing for the CDBG. Resolution 2016-01 authorizing the Submission of an Application for the Small Cities CDBG Program was motioned and passed. Resolution 2016-02 authorizing implementation of Long Term and Short Term Objectives and Resolution 2016-03 \$25,000 Leverage for the CDBG Grant was motioned and passed. Dan Cox, Attorney for the Town of Bascom, provided an Interlocal Agreement between the Town of Bascom, Greenwood, Malone and Jackson County to apply for a SEARCH Grant to determine if it is feasible to supply water to the Town of Bascom. The Agreement was motioned and approved.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on May 10, 2016. Resolution No. 2016-05 for the new D.O.T. Road Maintenance and Compensation Agreement was motioned and passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on June 14, 2016. Phyllis Bowman was sworn in as the Mayor of the Town of Greenwood.

Councilperson Kathryn Mickel was sworn in again for another four (4) year term. The celebration for July 4th was discussed. The TRIM process begins July 1, 2016.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held July 12, 2016. The Amendment to the D.O.T. Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement was motioned and passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on August 9, 2016. Joanne Truitt from Woodman of the World presented an American Flag to Mayor Bowman for the Town Park. A Proclamation for Union Grove School designating August 26th -28th as Union Grove School Weekend was motioned and passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on September 13, 2016. Mayor Bowman thanked the community for its generous response to her appeal for recovery supplies to aid the relief of the Louisiana flood victims. A motion to approve Suzanne M. NeSmith as acting Town Clerk was motioned and passed. The Town of Greenwood has been awarded a \$600,000 grant for the upgrades to the water lines and installation of radio read meters.

A 10% penalty will be applied on the 15th of the month. **If the total bill, including late charges, is not paid by the 19th of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 20th of the current month.** If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account.
