WATER WHEELS

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on April 14, 2015. A Proclamation establishing April as Child Abuse Prevention Month was motioned and passed. A Proclamation establishing May as Civility Month was motion and passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on May 12, 2015. The subject of Sunday alcohol sales was brought back to Council and once again, a motion was made but no second. Resolution 2015-01 for the D.O.T. Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement was motioned and passed. A motion to approve the purchase of five (5) new "Welcome to Greenwood" signs was passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on June 9, 2015. The 2nd Public Hearing for the CDBG Program was held. The purpose of this grant is to replace all existing meters with radio read meters. Resolution 2015-02 authorizing Mayor Sanders to submit application to D.E.O. for approval of the CDBG-NR (Neighborhood Revitalization) was motioned and passed. Dan Cox, Attorney for the Town of Bascom, provided an Interlocal Agreement between the Town of Bascom, Greenwood and

Malone to apply for a SEARCH Grant to determine if it is feasible to supply water to the Town of Bascom. The Agreement was motioned and approved.

WATER CONSERVATION

Leaks outside the house may not seem as bad since they're not as visible but they can be just as wasteful as leaks indoors. Check for leaks in pipes, hoses, faucets and couplings to keep them drip free.

SAFETY

REMINDER

Water and garbage bills are mailed at the end of each month and are due by the 10th day of the following month. A 10% penalty will be applied on the 15th of the month. **If the total bill, including late charges, is not paid by the 19th of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 20th of the current month.** If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account.
