

ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING AN OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE ON THE SALE OR RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA, AND FIXING THE AMOUNTS THEREOF AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO PAY THE SAME:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA, that there is hereby levied occupational licenses on the sale of alcoholic beverages within the Town of Greenwood, Florida, as follows:

Retail Alcoholic Beverage Stores:

- A. Alcohol Content Unlimited \$ 225.00
- B. Beer and Wine 25.00
- C. Beer Only, on Premises 15.00
- Beer Only, off Premises 7.50

Any person found guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by imprisonment at hard labor in the Town of Greenwood for not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both at the discretion of the Mayor.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Town Council and its approval by the Mayor, or upon its becoming a law without such approval, and shall be published by posting in three public places in the Town of Greenwood, one of which shall be at the office of the Town Clerk.
