

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA, DETERMINING THE EXISTENCE OF AN EMERGENCY; REQUIRING RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA AND NON-RESIDENTS UTILIZING THE TOWN'S WATER SYSTEM TO DISPOSE OF ALL HOUSE-HOLD GARBAGE AND SOLID WASTES AT THE FACILITIES PROVIDED BY THE TOWN; ESTABLISHING AND REQUIRING THE PAYMENT OF A FEE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SAID GARBAGE AND SOLID WASTES; ALLOWING THE TOWN COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE USE OF SAID FACILITIES; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR USERS OF SAID FACILITIES; PROVIDING PENALTIES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jackson County, Florida, has been removing house-hold garbage and solid wastes from the town of Greenwood.

WHEREAS, Jackson County, Florida, has determined that it will cease to provide garbage and solid wastes removal from the town of Greenwood, effective July 1, 1987.

WHEREAS, the accumulation of solid wastes and house-hold garbage within the town would be hazardous to the health and welfare of residents of the town.

WHEREAS, the town must take immediate action to provide for the removal of house-hold garbage and solid wastes from the town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The town council of the town of Greenwood, Florida, hereby determines that the imminent cessation of removal of solid wastes and house-hold garbage from the town by the County constitutes an emergency requiring immediate action by the town council.

SECTION 2. Commencing on the effective date of this ordinance, all residents (whether person, firm, or corporation) of the town of Greenwood, Florida, and non-residents (who are utilizing the

town's public water system on a continuing basis) shall be required to dispose of all house-hold garbage and solid wastes generated by such individuals or entities in facilities provided by the town of Greenwood.

SECTION 3. All users of the town's disposal facilities shall be required to pay a monthly fee in the amount of \$450 for the use of said facilities.

SECTION 4. The town council may establish reasonable written rules and regulations pertaining to the time and manner of the use of the town's disposal facilities which shall be posted in a conspicuous manner at said facilities.

SECTION 5. The town council shall provide two identification cards per house-hold, business, or other user for presentation at the town's disposal facilities to allow the holder of the card to use the facility.

SECTION 6. Any person, firm, or corporation who makes use of the town's disposal facilities without presentation of an identification card to the proper authority at the facility or who wilfully violates any rule or regulation pertaining to the use of the facility duly enacted pursuant to this ordinance shall be guilty of a second degree misdemeanor punishable as provided by law.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1987.

Proposed emergency ordinance presented to the town council of the town of Greenwood, Florida, read in full, discussed with an opportunity for interested persons to be heard, and enacted by a two-thirds vote of the members of the town council on this the 16th day of June, 1987.
