## **REMINDER**

Water and garbage bills are mailed at the end of each month and are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the following month. At the Council Meeting held on November 13, 2018 the Town Council voted to waive late fees and cutoffs during the months of November and December.

## **TRASH FACILITY**

### **Reminder-Rules and Policies:**

Facility is open on Tuesdays and Saturdays from 7:30 am to 4:30 pm for the disposal of household garbage. Please present your garbage card to the garbage attendant, if requested. If you have lost or misplaced your card, please contact Town Hall for a replacement.

At this time, yard trash and debris, such as limbs, leaves, branches, etc, will not be accepted at the Garbage Facility.

The Roll-Off container is available for the disposal of light household items and this service is **ONLY** available on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month. There are no exceptions.
