

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2002-01; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida, has determined Ordinance 2002-1 controls the election procedures for municipal elections for the Town and that dates for qualification of candidates for municipal elections are not specifically stated in said Ordinance, and that dates for qualification of candidates for municipal elections should be controlled and specifically stated by Ordinance;
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Section 6 of Ordinance 2002-01, as existing prior to this amendment states:

Any United States citizen who is a registered elector of Jackson County, Florida and who resides within the Town of Greenwood, may qualify as an elector of the Town of Greenwood. Any candidate for an elected office of the town must be a qualified elector of the town and must have resided within the town for one year immediately proceeding the election in which they are a candidate. Elections shall be at large.

Section 6 of Ordinance 2002-01 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any United States citizen who is a registered elector of Jackson County, Florida and who resides within the Town of Greenwood, may qualify as an elector of the Town of Greenwood. Any candidate for an elected office of the town must be a qualified elector of the town and must have resided within the town for one year immediately preceding the election in which they are a candidate. Elections shall be at large. Qualifying dates for offices of Town Council or Mayor are hereby set as the second Friday in May and the four business days immediately preceding the second Friday in May of each election year.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the Town Council.

Proposed ordinance presented to the Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida, and read in full, and discussed with an opportunity for interested persons to be heard at the May 11, 2004, regular meeting.

Proposed ordinance noticed once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Greenwood, Florida, at least ten days prior to its adoption.

Proposed ordinance read by title before the Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida, at the June 8, 2004, meeting, interested parties who appeared before the Town Council being heard, and proposed ordinance passed by at least two affirmative votes of members of the Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida, at said meeting.
