The Town held our 2nd Annual July 4th Celebration at the Greenwood Park. It was a wonderful day that started with decorating our bicycles, carts and cars for participation in a grand parade from Town Hall to the Park. We had water slides, live music, and games for the children along with free hotdogs and watermelon. Some vendors sold their homemade items and others gave away boiled peanuts and water to all. The Mayor, Council and Staff would like to thank everyone who helped make this day a special celebration of Our Great Country's birthday. We look forward to all of you joining us again next year.

The Town of Greenwood has two water projects currently in process. In November 2016, the Town received notification that a \$600,000 Community Development Block Grant, from the FL Department of Economic Opportunity was

awarded for the replacement of approximately 250 water service laterals (6,565 linear feet) and the installation of new residential radio-read water meters at these locations. The Town also submitted an application for funding to USDA-Rural Development for the construction of a new water well and was approved for a grant/loan in the amount of \$761,325. These projects should be started in the near future. REMINDER

Water and garbage bills are mailed at the end of each month and are due by the 10th day of the following month. A 10% late fee will be applied if not paid by the 15th of the month. **If the total bill, including late fees, is not paid by the 20th of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 21st of the current month.** If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and a \$40.00 reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account. As of February 2017, the Town is now able to process credit/debit card payments.
