The Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida met for a Budget Hearing in the Greenwood Town Hall at 5:01 p.m. on the 17<sup>TH</sup> day of September, 2019. The place, time, and date heretofore established for the holding of such meetings.

Mayor Phyllis Bowman called the meeting to order.

The first item on the agenda was Resolution No. 2019-08 a resolution of the Town of Greenwood of Jackson County, Florida, adopting the final levying of Ad Valorem taxes for Jackson County for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 and providing an effective date. The FY 2019-2020 operating millage is 1 mill, which will result in a decrease of the rolled back rate of 1.078 by -7.24 percent. A motion to adopt Resolution No. 2019-08 as read by title was made by CM Johnson, with a second from CM Ditty. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Vann – Yes Ditty – Yes. Motion passed at 5:02 p.m.

The next item on the agenda was Resolution No. 2019-09 a resolution adopting a budget for the Town of Greenwood, Florida, for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020; and providing an effective date. The adopted tentative budget as amended for the Town of Greenwood is the Town's final budget for the FY beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020. A motion to adopt Resolution No. 2019-09 as read by title was made by CM Johnson, with a second from CM Vann. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Vann – Yes Ditty – Yes. Motion passed at 5:03 pm.

A motion to adjourn was made by CM Ditty, with a second by CM Vann. Vote called. Johnson-- Yes. Ditty – Yes. Vann – Yes. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 5:04 p.m.
