

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE GREENWOOD TOWN COUNCIL
GREENWOOD, FLORIDA
June 12, 2018**

The Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida met in a regular session in the Greenwood Town Hall at 6:30 p.m. on the 12th day of June, 2018. The place, time, and date heretofore established for the holding of such meetings.

Mayor Phyllis Bowman called the meeting to order.

Everyone present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Mayor Bowman asked all present for a moment of silence in honor of our military.

Jacky Ditty and Mamie Vann were sworn in as Councilmembers for a term of four (4) years.

The Clerk declared a quorum present.

A motion to approve the minutes and the financials for May, 2018 as presented was made by Mamie Vann. Second by Bryan Johnson. Vote called. Vann – Yes. Johnson – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Passed.

Matt Mathews, Chapter President of The Sons of the American Revolution presented the Mayor and the Town of Greenwood with a framed copy of The Declaration of Independence donated by the William Dunaway Chapter of the Sons of the American Revolution.

Dr. Fred Fitzgerald addressed the Council regarding his concerns about the existing crosswalks at the intersection of SR71/SR69/CR162. He stated the crosswalk needs to be repainted as well as the reflective lines on the street. Dr. Fitzgerald also requested the SR71 sign on CR162 be replaced. Dr. Fitzgerald requested that a crosswalk be installed on SR71 south from Smith Street to the Greenwood Baptist Church. Town Clerk, Alicia Corder stated she will send a formal request with all Dr. Fitzgerald concerns to the Dept of Transportation for review.

Dr. Fitzgerald would also like to see a Senior Citizens Center established in the Town of Greenwood. He would offer the Greenwood Baptist Church's Fellowship Hall at no cost to the center. He requested any assistance the Town could provide with speaking with the new administration of the Jackson County Senior Citizens or the JC Board of County Commissioners. Bryan Johnson inquired how often the center would be open and Dr. Fitzgerald replied hopefully Monday – Friday during the day.

Attorney Little stated there are no updates on any legal issues concerning the Town.

Alicia Corder gave clerk notes. Mrs. Corder updated Council on the progress of the cleanup projects at Well # 2 and the maintenance yard and provided the Council with a copy of the estimated costs. The Town has received a quote from Gibbs Concrete LLC. for concrete work in the amount of \$4,100.00. Councilmembers requested that we obtain additional quotes for the concrete work to ensure that the Town is receiving a fair and competitive price. Bryan Johnson made a motion to obtain additional quotes and accept the best quote so the Town can proceed with the project. Second by Mamie Vann. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Vann – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Passed.

Mayor Bowman took a moment to remind everyone about our upcoming July 4th Celebration at the Greenwood Town Park on Wednesday, July 4. This year we will be incorporating our Emergency Preparedness Day at the same event.

A motion to adjourn was made by Bryan Johnson. Second by Mamie Vann. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Vann – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Passed.

Meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held on July 10, 2018 at 6:30 PM.
