The Council was presented with a draft Option to Purchase agreement for the purpose of securing a parcel of land needed for the new water well project. The cost of purchasing the property for the project is covered in the USDA-Rural Utilities Service grant/loan application up to \$26,000. The proposed location of the new water well is on Basswood Road. Mayor Bowman spoke with Mr. Mark Banks regarding a parcel of land and Mr. Banks does not want to commit to sell at this time. Mayor Bowman will continue to pursue a commitment for a new well site. If the Town is unable to secure property located on Basswood Road, then there is an option to relocate the project to land located near the existing 8" water line located off of Highway 71. A motion was made by Bryan Johnson to allow Mayor Bowman to negotiate and enter into an Option to Purchase agreement for land purchase. Second by Mamie Vann. Vote called. Andreasen – Yes. Vann– Yes.
