

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE GREENWOOD TOWN COUNCIL  
GREENWOOD, FLORIDA  
October 16, 2018**

The Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida met in a regular session in the Greenwood Town Hall at 3:37 p.m. on the 16th day of October, 2018. The place, time, and date heretofore established for the holding of such meetings.

Mayor Phyllis Bowman called the meeting to order.

The Clerk declared a quorum present.

The subject of an Interlocal Agreement between the Town of Greenwood and Jackson County for the debris removal from all of the Town of Greenwood roadways was discussed. Jackson County has hired 3 contractors to remove the debris from the roadways in all of Jackson County. Mayor Bowman, Town Clerk Alicia Corder and Attorney George Little attended a meeting earlier today. The State of Florida will provide monitoring on the reimbursement from FEMA. There will be no other independent firm doing the monitoring. It is the recommendation of Attorney Little that we enter into the Interlocal Agreement with Jackson County so that we may move forward with the cleanup efforts for the Town and its citizens. It would be more cost effective for the Town than hiring our own firm to remove debris. A motion to enter into the Interlocal Agreement 2018 Hurricane Michael FEMA Relief with Jackson County for the debris removal was made by Bryan Johnson. Second by Jacky Ditty. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Vann – Yes. Passed.

Attorney Little was not present. No legals.

Alicia Corder, Town Clerk gave clerk notes. Mrs. Corder advised the Council of all of the Towns current efforts to help its residents during this crisis. The roll off has been emptied and debris removed in the trash facility so people may dispose of their debris. The trash facility will be open Monday: 12:00 - 4:30, Tuesday: regular hours, Wednesday:12:00 - 4:30, Thursday: 12:00 - 4:30, Friday: 12:00 - 4:30, and Saturday; regular hours.

Town Hall will be open daily to distribute supplies to all people in need. The Red Cross will be in the parking lot of Town Hall daily for lunch and dinner. The Town will not charge late fees or disconnect any acct for nonpayment this month. The billing for October will be an average for 12 months due to the fact that we are unable to read most of the meters in the town due to debris. Florida Public Utilities will be installing a generator at Town Hall tomorrow. We have been advised it will be approximately two weeks for the return of electricity. The town will continue to distribute supplies and possibly have a Point of Distribution set up at a location in Greenwood. Mrs. Corder stated all in all the town and distribution of supplies is running smoothly.


