~PROCLAMATION~

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States established a foundation for the success of our nation through core beliefs such as popular sovereignty and limited government; and

WHEREAS, September 17, 2018, marks the two hundred thirty-first anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the constitutional convention; and

WHEREAS, Constitution Week was officially declared and established by President Dwight D. Eisenhower on August 2, 1956, and

WHEREAS, 36 U.S.C. § 108, as amended, requests the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary; and the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion throughout Florida and across our nation; and

NOW, THEREFORE I, Phyllis Bowman, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the Town of Greenwood, Florida do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 - 23, 2018 as

"CONSTITUTION WEEK"

AND ask our citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
