The Town of Greenwood is accepting Requests for Qualifications from qualified engineering firms to provide professional engineering services for the Town of Greenwood. The Town intends to apply for a SEARCH GRANT from USDA Rural Development Community Water and Wastewater Program for study of the Town future sewer needs.

The Scope and services desired shall include, but not necessarily be limited to the following: Preliminary Engineering, environmental assessment, develop project cost, application for funding and to include design, bidding and construction services.

Evaluation of responding firms will be based on the following criteria:

1. Professional background and caliber of previous experience of each person of your firm and of each of your consultants to be assigned to this project. Please identify their precise role in accomplishing the work.
2. Do you propose to use the services of a specialty consultant? If so, please indicate name, address and previous affiliations.
3. Recent experience on similar projects, including experience working with Rural Development SEARCH GRANT process.
4. Capability of the firm to perform the work on schedule.
5. Firm's familiarity with the water needs of the community.
6. Reputation for personal and professional integrity and competence.

Please furnish 5 copies of your submittal to Town of Greenwood, 4207 Bryan Street, Greenwood, Florida 32443 by April 19, 2018 by 12:00 P.M. All professional engineering firms who consider themselves qualified for this work are invited to submit a proposal.
