

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE GREENWOOD TOWN COUNCIL  
GREENWOOD, FLORIDA  
September 11, 2018**

The Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida met in a regular session in the Greenwood Town Hall at 6:30 p.m. on the 11th day of September, 2018. The place, time, and date heretofore established for the holding of such meetings.

Mayor Phyllis Bowman called the meeting to order.

Everyone present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Mayor Bowman asked all present for a moment of silence in honor of our military.

The Clerk declared a quorum present.

Mayor Bowman introduced Mr. Tony Mayo to the Council and guests. Mr. Mayo and his family came before Council to thank them, the Mayor and the generous people of Greenwood for their support during the recent Boston Butt fundraiser held to help his family after the loss of everything in a house fire.

Our first agenda item was the Proclamation for Constitution Week, September 17-23, 2018. Mayor Bowman read the Proclamation to the Council and guests.

A motion to approve the minutes and financials for August, 2018 with corrections was made by Mamie Vann. Second by Jacky Ditty. Vote called. Vann – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Johnson – Yes. Passed.

Next on the agenda was in regards to a code enforcement lien on 5179 Albernathy Street. This agenda item was tabled until our next meeting so Attorney Little may be present to answer any inquiries.

Attorney Little was not present. No legals.

Alicia Corder, Town Clerk gave clerk notes. Mrs. Corder provided Council with copies of two (2) quotes for the debris removal at the Greenwood Trash Facility. Alday's Tree Service quoted \$1600.00 for initial removal of debris and \$300.00 per load for any future removal of debris. Branching Out Tree Service quoted a flat fee of \$300.00 per load and estimated that it would take 10 or more loads to remove the debris. After a brief discussion a motion was made by Bryan Johnson to hire Alday Tree Service to dispose of the debris. Second by Mamie Vann. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Vann – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Passed.

Mrs. Corder provided Council with a copy of Clifford Howard's performance evaluation. Mr. Howard's probationary period will end on September 16, 2018. Mrs. Corder recommended the Council approve the hiring of Mr. Howard as a permanent full time employee. Mr. Howard will receive a \$1.00 per hour raise and his starting salary will be \$12.50 per hour. A motion to hire Mr. Howard as our full time Public Works Supervisor was made by Jacky Ditty. Second by Mamie Vann. Vote called. Ditty – Yes. Vann – Yes. Johnson – Yes Passed.

Mayor Bowman informed Council and guests that our Annual Harvest Day Festival will be held on Saturday, October 13, 2018. This year it will begin at 10:00 am to coincide with a church revival being held all day at the Greenwood Park.

Meeting adjourned at 6:53 PM. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held on October 9, 2018 at 6:30 PM.
