

**MINUTES OF THE TRIM & BUDGET MEETING  
OF THE GREENWOOD TOWN COUNCIL  
GREENWOOD, FLORIDA  
September 3, 2019**

The Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida met for a TRIM & Budget meeting in the Greenwood Town Hall at 5:01 p.m. on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2019. The place, time, and date heretofore established for the holding of such meetings.

Mayor Phyllis Bowman called the meeting to order.

Everyone present stood for the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

The Clerk declared a quorum present.

The first item on the agenda was the review of the changes made to the General Fund and Revenue Fund budgets. Council was given an updated budget with the changes discussed during the Budget Workshop held on August 15, 2019. The Council was informed of the update made to the annual loan repayment for the USDA loan for the new well project. Also, the CDBG grant income and expenses were removed from the FY 2019-2020 budget; the grant will be closed out prior to the end of the current fiscal year (9-30-2019). There were no further changes made during the discussion.

The next item on the agenda was the proposed ad valorem millage rate for FY 2019-2020. Council was informed the Town's rollback for FY 2018-2019 was 1.078 mill. There is a small decrease from the previous year's ad valorem taxes due to the reduction in property values. The proposed ad valorem millage rate for FY 2019-2020 is 1 mill per \$1,000. This will result in a -0.078 percent change of the roll back rate of 1.078 mill. A budget hearing to adopt the FY 2019-2020 millage rate and budget will be held on September 17, 2019 at 5:01 p.m. A motion was made by CM Johnson to tentatively adopt the 1.000 millage rate for FY 2019-2020, with a second from CM Ditty. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Motion passed.

The next item on the agenda was the review of the proposed budget for FY 2019-2020. A motion was made by CM Johnson to tentatively adopt the proposed budget for FY 2019-2020 as presented, with a second from CM Ditty. Vote called. Johnson – Yes. Ditty – Yes. Motion passed.

A motion to adjourn was made by CM Johnson, with a second by CM Vann. Vote called. Johnson– Yes. Ditty – Yes. Vann – Yes. Passed. Meeting adjourned at 5:12 PM. The next regular meeting of the Town Council will be held on September 10, 2019 at 6:30 PM.
