REMINDER

Water and garbage bills are mailed at the end of each month and are due by the 10th day of the following month. A 10% penalty will be applied on the 15th of the month. **If the total bill, including late charges, is not paid by the 20th of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 21st of the current month.** If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and a \$40.00 reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account. As of February 2017, the Town is now able to process credit/debit card payments.
