AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA; SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID MUNICIPALITY A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ITS CHARTER.

WHEREAS the Town Council of the Town of Greenwood, Florida, has determined that the charter for said town should be amended and that the proposed amendment to its charter should be submitted to the electors of the town at a special election called for such purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA:

That the proposed amendment to the existing town charter, Chapter 12779, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1927, as amended by Chapter 57-1344, Laws of Florida, Special Acts of 1957, the original proposed amendment being attached hereto, be submitted to the electors of the Town of Greenwood at a special election called for its adoption and ratification or rejection by a majority of the electors voting in the referendum upon such amendment.

Proposed ordinance presented to the town council of the town of Greenwood, Florida, and read in full, and discussed with an opportunity for interested persons to be heard at the December 12, 1989, regular meeting.

Proposed ordinance noticed once in a newspaper of general circulation in the town of Greenwood, Florida, at least ten days prior to its adoption.

Proposed ordinance read by title before the town council of the town of Greenwood, Florida, at the February 13, 1990, regular meeting, interested parties who appeared before the town council being heard, and proposed ordinance passed by at least two affirmative votes of members of the town council of the town of

Greenwood, Florida at said meeting.
