ORDINANCE NUMBER 2010-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENWOOD, FLORIDA, REPEALING PRIOR ORDINANCES CONCERNING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY AND OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY, CHANGING THE PENALTY FOR ALCOHOL SALES ON SUNDAY, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

- **WHEREAS**; the Town of Greenwood has determined that its prior ordinance requiring an occupational license from the Town for the sale of alcoholic beverages within the Town is inconsistent with current State law, and
- WHEREAS; the Town of Greenwood has determined that its prior ordinance prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages within the Town between the hours of midnight Saturday night and 6:00 a.m. Monday morning provides for penalties that the Town cannot enforce in the absence of a municipal police department and municipal correctional facilities; and
- **WHEREAS**; the Town of Greenwood does not desire at this time to eliminate the prohibition of alcohol sales on Sunday, but desires to create a more realistic and enforceable civil penalty;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted:

- **SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 100 of the Town of Greenwood, enacted July 31, 1967, imposing an occupational license on the sale of retail alcoholic beverages within the Town of Greenwood, and fixing the amounts thereof and providing penalties for failure to pay the same, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- **SECTION 2**. Ordinance No. 6 of the Town of Greenwood, enacted March 29, 1954, prohibiting the sale of any intoxicating liquors, wines, or beer in the Town of Greenwood between the hours of midnight Saturday night and 6:00 a.m. Monday morning, is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- **SECTION 3.** It shall be a civil infraction for any entity or person to sell or cause to be sold, between the hours of midnight Saturday night and Six O'Clock a.m. Monday morning, any intoxicating liquors, wines, or beer within the Town of Greenwood, Florida.
- **SECTION 4.** Any person or entity violating Section 3 of this ordinance shall be cited by the Code Enforcement Officer of the Town of Greenwood and, after notice and opportunity for hearing, may be fined not exceeding \$50.00 per violation.
- **SECTION 5.** All prior ordinances or provisions of prior ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are repeal.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective upon adoption.
