WATER WHEELS

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on July 14, 2015. A discussion was held regarding the complaints we have received regarding the upkeep and maintenance of the Town and Park. With the equipment and manpower we presently have a recommendation was made to hire a temporary part time employee to strictly mow the Park at a maximum of six (6) hours per week. A motion was made and approved.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on August 11, 2015. Mrs. Croxton advised Council, due to the new requirements for D.O.T., a new Preventative Maintenance Agreement is necessary to fulfill our obligation with D.O.T. This agreement was motioned and passed.

A Special Town Council Meeting was held on September 10, 2015. Tentative adoption of the millage rate at 1 mill and the budgets for the FY2015/2016 were motioned and passed.

A Special Town Council Meeting was held on September 22, 2015 for the final adoption of the millage rate at 1 mill and the FY2015/2016 budgets.

Both were motioned and passed.

REMINDER

A 10% penalty will be applied on the 15th of the month. **If the total bill, including late charges, is not paid by the 19th of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 20th of the current month.** If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account.
