

WATER WHEELS

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on October 14, 2014. Mayor Sanders read final reading of Ordinance No. 2014-01 amending Ordinance No. 101 pertaining to the allowable footage between an alcohol beverage vendor and an established church or school. The final reading for Ordinance No. 2014-01 was motioned and passed. Mayor Sanders advised Bobby Lee with CDG Engineers has applied for a grant in the amount of \$900,000 for a third well.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on November 20, 2014. The 2013/2014 amended budget was motioned and passed.

The regular Town Council Meeting was held on December 9, 2014. Resolution No. 2014-06 Promoting Education of Families Regarding Tobacco Advertising Techniques Directed to Youth was motioned and passed. An amendment to the D.O.T. Traffic Signal Maintenance and Compensation Agreement was motioned and passed.

The D.E.O. Technical Assistance Grant in the amount of \$20,000 for updating the Town's Comprehensive Plan was motioned and passed. A motion was made and passed for Andy Easton & Associates as consultant for updating the Town's Comprehensive Plan funded by the D.E.O. Technical Assistance Grant. The Town was not approved for the CDBG to refurbish well #1. For the next CDBG cycle, the Council motioned and approved to change the project to install radio read meters, lowering the grant request to approximately \$250,000.

If the total bill, including late charges, is not paid by the 19th of the month your services will be turned-off/suspended (in the morning) on the 20th of the current month. If your water/garbage is turned-off/suspended, the entire bill including late charges and reconnect fee must be paid in order to reactivate your account.
